V251	Insertion of intrauterine contraceptive device
V252	Sterilization
V2540	Contraceptive surveillance, unspecified
V2541	Surveillance of contraceptive pill
V2542	Surveillance of intrauterine contraceptive device
V2543	Surveillance of implantable subdermal contraceptive
V2549	Surveillance of other contraceptive method
V255	Insertion of implantable subdermal contraceptive
