Definitions:

DHS referrals to CHIP: children deemed CHIP eligible by DHS with DHS Application for assistance (Form 1010). Referral originates at DHS.

DHS responses to CHIP referrals: number of CHIP referrals completed by DHS

DHS responses to CHIP referrals pending: number of CHIP referrals pending action by DHS

Currently receiving Medicaid: child referred by CHIP already receiving Medicaid.

Determined Medicaid/spillover: certified for Medicaid based on CHIP referral and did not receive Medicaid/TANF for six months before the application month.

Determined Medicaid/not spillover: certified for Medicaid based on CHIP referral, received Medicaid/TANF within six months of application month.

Denied for Income/deemed CHIP: ineligible for Medicaid, referred back to CHIP in response to CHIP referral. CHIP sends enrollment package.

Denied for Income/not CHIP: over 200% FPIL, referred back to CHIP to send to TDI.

***Ineligible LPR/Deemed CHIP:** effective April 1, 2001 ineligible for Medicaid based on LPR status, referral to CHIP.

Denied for Resources/Deemed CHIP: ineligible for Medicaid, referred back to CHIP in response to CHIP referral. CHIP sends enrollment package.

Denied for Failure to Keep Appointment: effective September 1, referrals sent to DHS that fail to keep scheduled appointment recorded.

Denied for Failure to Provide Information: effective September 1, referrals sent to DHS that fail to return requested information recorded.

***Denied/Undocumented Alien:** effective April 1, 2001 ineligible for Medicaid based on alien status.

Denied App/unknown: number prior to September 1, 2000 included missed appointment, asset related denials, failure to provide requested information, no eligible child, residence, citizenship, voluntary withdrawal or applicant failing to respond to DHS request for appointment. Effective September 1, 2000 this number represents denials due to no eligible child, residence, citizenship, voluntary withdrawal or applicant failing to respond to DHS request for appointment.
