Come and learn how to increase participation and motivate members to meet the diverse service needs of children, youth, adults and families served through CRCGs.

### **Session 2: CRCG Resource Development**

*A panel of local CRCG experts will provide inside perspectives of how their CRCGs have successfully discovered and leveraged resources, including services, supports and funding that has enabled them to become more effective. Urban and rural perspectives will be offered.*
